

GIRLS VOLLEYBALL - 6TH, 7TH, 8TH GRADES

PARENT MEETING. A parent meeting will be held on Sunday, January 22 at 5:00 pm in Gymnasium II (NEW GYM).

Only players who have submitted necessary forms and fees by February 3 will be considered for CSAL teams. Also girls may not play volleyball and also participate in track.

Tryouts will be held in the old gym (except as indicated otherwise) as follows:

Tryouts are restricted to girls eligible to participate in CSAL school-sponsored sports.

The **6th Grade team** is open to girls in the 6th grade who were at least 10 on September 1st and who did not become 13 prior to September 1st. The 6th Grade Team will consist of no more than 12 players.

The **7th Grade team** is open to girls in the 7th grade who did not become 14 prior to September 1st. The 7th Grade Team will consist of no more than 12 players.

The **8th Grade team** is open to girls in the 8th grade who did not become 15 prior to September 1st. However, a girl repeating the 8th grade who has previously participated in CSAL volleyball as an 8th grader is not eligible. The 8th Grade Team will consist of no more than 12 players.

SAS ELIGIBILITY - The school administration may remove any student from eligibility should a serious incident occur during the school day or at a sports or school related activity. Eligibility is based on report cards and disciplinary matters in each nine week period and is reevaluated at the end of the next nine-week period. (See the School Parent/Student Handbook for details.)

Practice. Practices are Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday based on coach and gym availability.

CSAL Season. The jamboree game will be played between February 29 and March 3. The regular season will begin March 5th and end by the first week in May. The maximum number of league matches for each league is 14. League matches are played on weekday evenings and Saturday mornings. In addition, each team will play in a maximum of three weekend tournaments. No standings will be kept nor any championship recognized or award given.

Uniform. Each player will be issued a match jersey and match short. These items, as well as white socks, are to be worn at matches and must be returned by the players after the season. [See **Uniform Contract and Conflicts Form.**]

Equipment. Each player must provide her own shoes and wear plain white socks during matches.

Fee. The fee is \$130 - **payable to "St. Aloysius Athletic Department"** (Discount to \$95 if, within the current school year, a registration fee has been paid for the student or a sibling for (a) 5th to 8th grade football or 5th to 8th grade basketball or (b) has a sister who is playing CSAL volleyball so long as one \$130 fee is paid. The \$130 fee includes your child's CSAL or CYO registration and tickets to the SAS Athletic Department Dinner on March 9th. (The tickets will be distributed about two weeks prior to the Dinner.)

PLAYER PARTICIPATION. Team members will receive adequate playing time. However, match participation may be based on attendance and participation at practice, attendance at matches, conduct, and attitude. In the 6th and 7th grades, each player present and available to play must play at least one game without substitution during one of the three games in the match. A third game will be played in the 6th and 7th grades, regardless of outcome of the first two games. A waiver is permitted for injury, disqualified player, and disciplinary action.

REQUIRED FORMS - Each student must, prior to such participation, provide (1) a completed uniform contract and conflicts form, (2) a completed medical history evaluation form and physical exam which verifies that the student is physically able to participate, (3) a completed registration, consent, medical authorization, acknowledgment, and waiver form, (4) the Athletic Participation Contract form, and (5) a completed parent/athlete concussion information sheet. (These are attached and are available on the school website.) Forms (2), (3), (4), and (5) do not need to be submitted again if already turned in for the student for basketball. In addition, CYO players must complete and submit a CYO player registration form, which will be distributed at practice. **No player may participate in practice until the required fee and forms are submitted to school to Ann Soike and confirmed by the athletic director.**

CYO VOLLEYBALL (school based) - The CYO sponsors a volleyball program for girls in the 6th, 7th, and 8th grades who are not participating on a CSAL team. Practice will start in February and the season will end by early May. **Only girls that are eligible to participate in CSAL basketball and who participate in CSAL tryouts may play CYO.** Details will be distributed later.

PARENTAL PARTICIPATION. Parent participation is a necessary part of a successful sports program. Parents are responsible for getting their child to practices and contests on time and with the necessary equipment and are to pick up their child after practice or a contest on time. Parent assistance is also needed in the collection of admission charges and the manning of the concession area at home matches and at our tournament. After team rosters are determined and league schedules received, a work schedule will be prepared and sent to the parents of team members with specific assignments for home matches on a rotating basis. These assignments will be made in a manner that the parent will be free to watch his or her child's match.

NOTE: Jewelry may not be worn during matches and warm-ups. Earrings of any type are not permitted. Tape over earrings will not be permitted. Consider this before allowing your child to have her ears pierced during the volleyball season.
