

BOYS BASKETBALL- 6TH, 7TH, 8TH GRADES

PARENT MEETING. A parent meeting will be held on Sunday, November 13 at 6:40 pm in Gymnasium II (new gym).

Only players who have submitted necessary forms and fees by November 14 will be considered for CSAL teams.

Tryouts for CSAL teams will be according to the following schedule in the NEW GYM:

Monday, 11/14	5:30-6:45	6:45-8:00	8:00-9:15
Tuesday, 11/15	5:30-6:45	6:45-8:00	8:00-9:15

Tryouts are limited to boys currently eligible to participate in CSAL school-sponsored sports.

The **6th Grade team** is open to boys in the 6th grade who were at least 10 on September 1st and who did not become 13 prior to September 1st. The 6th Grade team will consist of no more than 10 players.

The **7th Grade team** is open to boys in the 7th grade who did not become 14 prior to September 1st. The 7th Grade team will consist of no more than 10 players.

The **8th Grade team** is open to boys in the 8th grade who did not become 15 prior to September 1st. However, a boy repeating the 8th grade who previously participated in CSAL basketball as an 8th grader is not eligible. The 8th Grade team will consist of no more than 10 players.

SAS ELIGIBILITY - The school administration may remove any student from eligibility should a serious incident occur during the school day or at a sports or school related activity. Eligibility is based on report cards and disciplinary matters in each nine week reporting period and is reevaluated at the end of the next nine-week reporting period. (Refer to the School Parent/Student Handbook for further details.)

Practice. Practices are held Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday after school and sometimes on weekends based on coach and gym availability.

CSAL Season. The jamboree will be played between December 7-10. The regular season will begin on December 12th. The maximum number of league games is 14. League games are played on weekday evenings and Saturday mornings. In addition, each team may play in a maximum of two weekend tournaments. No standings are kept, championship recognized, or award given.

Uniform. Each player will be issued a jersey and short. These items are to be worn at games and must be returned after the season. [**See Uniform Contract and Conflicts Form.**]

Equipment. Each player must provide his own shoes and wear plain white socks during games.

Fee. The fee is \$130 - **payable to "St. Aloysius Athletic Department"** (Discount to \$95 if, within the current school year, a registration fee has been paid for the student or a sibling for 5th to 8th grade CSAL or CYO boys football or girls basketball). The fee includes your son's CSAL/CYO registration.

PLAYER PARTICIPATION. Team members will receive adequate playing time. However, game participation may be based on attendance and participation at practice, attendance at games, conduct, and attitude. In the 6th and 7th grades, each player present and available to play at a league game must play at least one quarter without substitution during the game. A waiver is permitted for injury, disqualified player, and disciplinary action.

REQUIRED FORMS - Each student must, prior to such participation, provide (1) a completed uniform contract and conflicts form, (2) a completed medical history evaluation form which verifies that the student is physically able to participate, (3) a completed registration, consent, medical authorization, acknowledgment, and waiver form, (4) the Athletic Participation Contract form, and (5) a completed parent/athlete concussion information sheet. (These are attached and are available on the school's website.) Forms (2), (3), (4), and (5) do not need to be submitted again if already turned in for the student for football. In addition, CYO players must complete and submit a CYO player registration form, which will be distributed at practice.

No otherwise eligible player may participate in practice until the required fee and forms are submitted to the school to Ann Soike and confirmed by the athletic director.

PARENTAL PARTICIPATION. Parent participation is a necessary part of a successful sports program. Parents are responsible for getting their child to practices and games on time and with the necessary equipment and are to pick up their child after practice or a contest on time.

Parent assistance is also needed in the collection of admission charges and the manning of the concession area at home games. After team rosters are determined and league schedules received, a work schedule will be prepared and sent to the parents of team members with specific assignments for home games on a rotating basis.

CYO BASKETBALL (school based) - The CYO sponsors a basketball program for boys in the 6th, 7th, and 8th grades who are not participating on a CSAL team. Practice will start in after Thanksgiving and the season will end in March. No standings will be kept nor championship recognized or awards given in the league. Games will be played at the participating schools. **Only boys who participate in CSAL tryouts may play CYO.**
