Permission for Over the Counter Medication

**Middle School Only**  
**Grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>**

Parents may give written permission to give any of the following:

- + Acetaminophen (Tylenol)
- + Ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin)
- + Cough Drops
- + Diphenhydramine (Benadryl) allergic reaction only

All of the above will be stocked in the First Aid Room. According to the policy and procedure, the school nurse will perform a history and physical assessment of the student's pain or discomfort. For example, the nurse would question the child about the lack of meals or about previous medication use. Comfort measures, such as eating, cold compress, positioning, rest, are used first. Children are weighed, and weight ranges are used for dosage requirements. A parent will be notified prior to medication administered. Medication is then given and recorded.

**If administration of over the counter medication is given more than three times a physicians order will be required before medication will be administered again.**
