

St. Aloysius Confirmation Mass Information

Tuesday, October 29th, 2024

What time is the Confirmation Mass?

Mass will begin at 7 pm. It would be wise to arrive early; seating will be limited, and the candidates will process in at 6:55 pm. It will end around 8:30 pm.

When to arrive:

Candidates and sponsors should meet in the parish hall at 6 pm. Family and friends should arrive early.

Where to sit:

Candidates and sponsors will sit in the nave of the church. Seating is assigned; please check our seating charts at <https://www.aloysius.org/confirmation>. The candidate's certificate and name tag will be in their assigned seat. Family and friends should find seats on their own.

Photos with the bishop:

Bishop Duca will take photos with candidates starting around 6 pm each evening in the parish hall. Photos may continue after Mass. We will not have a photographer; please bring your own camera.

Who can attend Mass:

We do not have restrictions on who can attend our Confirmation Masses. Be aware that we are only reserving seats for the candidates and sponsors; family and friends should find seats on their own.

How to watch the Mass live:

Our Mass will be livestreamed; the stream will begin at 6:30 pm.

Dress code for candidates and sponsors:

Candidates and sponsors, this is a FORMAL event and YOU are the main attraction, i.e. subject of photos, videos, etc. Proper clothes to wear:

- Gentlemen: Dress suit with tie or coat and tie plus dress shoes.
- Ladies: Dress, pantsuit, or skirt and blouse plus dress shoes. No strapless or low-cut dresses. Bring a wrap or sweater if you choose to wear spaghetti-strap. Dresses or skirts on or close to the knee line.
- Sponsors should follow the same dress code as the candidates.

Masks:

Be aware that we expect this Mass to be well-attended. Masks are not required, but we support anyone who wants to wear a mask.
