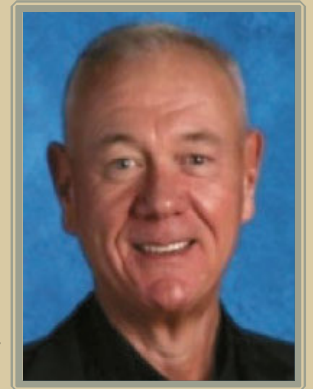

Our Challenge

Dear friends:

The author of the Book of Sirach warns against holding on to wrath. We cannot stoke the fires of anger against others and expect healing from God. If we expect God to let go of our sins, we must let go of our neighbors' sins. There can be no double standard when it comes to God's response and our responses. St. Paul says we are the Lord's, both in life and in death. We are hardly the captains of our own fate. Our lives have meaning when we walk in the ways of Christ - loving our enemies, forgiving our oppressors, telling the truth, and doing good. We have nothing to fear because we belong to Christ. In our gospel passage this weekend, Peter thought he was being generous when he proposed forgiving someone seven times. Jesus insisted that he forgive seventy times seven. This means that forgiving love never keeps score. Forgiving love has no limits, but continues to forgive. "Belonging" is a critical part of an individual's importance in our culture. Badges of belonging indicate membership in this civic club or that charitable organization. Decals, plaques, and awards are displayed...lest the world not know that a truly substantive person is nearby. Genuinely secure people don't need to advertise. Some people have lives so different from ours that it would be impossible to imagine them. Most people, however, even those most disadvantaged, live in circumstances we can at least imagine. The Bible is an ideal book for a person in need of an identity. Genesis tells us we are made in the image of God, which is very impressive. We are also the "children of God," gifted and chosen to serve God. In addition, Christ is our "brother." But the Apostle Paul has added to all this that we "belong" to Christ. In life and in death, he says, we belong to Christ. When you were baptized, you became a son or daughter of God. Yet, when someone asks you who you are, that is rarely how you identify yourself...which is a shame, because what remarkable identities we have!

"Jesus and the Eucharist:" An Invitation to Renewal!



Beginning **Thursday, September 21, at 6:00 PM in the Parish Hall**, St. Aloysius Church will be offering a unique opportunity to reflect and experience renewal in our devotion to God's gift of Himself in the Holy Eucharist.

Every parish across the country is being invited to host "**Jesus and the Eucharist**," a seven-part video study that serves as a key element in our on-going National Eucharistic Revival. The study offers a short-course in the Catholic Faith, focusing on the **Biblical Story of Salvation**, the **Identity of Jesus**, the **Gift of Salvation**, the **Importance of the Church**, and the **Life-giving Treasure of the Most Blessed Sacrament**.

Each session opens with an exhortation from a different U.S. Catholic bishop, followed by *lectio divina* prayer with Scripture. Each lesson is drawn from content created by the **Augustine Institute** (producers of **FORMED.org**) and will include personal testimonies from Catholics across the country. We will then transition into small group discussions. Each session will be 2 hours or less.

The series is free, but we do need you to register so that we will have enough materials available for all participants. Also, we are planning to provide childcare for ages 1-5 in the Child Care Center, so we will need to know how many children to expect each evening. Finally, we're looking for volunteers to facilitate the discussions in the small groups. Worksheets and questions will be provided!

Children's Church is a great opportunity for adults and middle school/high school youth to volunteer and help eager youngsters learn the Word of the Lord. Children's Church is an age-appropriate Liturgy of the Word offered for children in PreK through 2nd grade at most 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM Masses. No pre-registration is necessary. All children are welcome and encouraged to attend. Just before the Liturgy of the Word begins for the assembly, the celebrant will invite the children to gather at the altar, receive a blessing, and then follow the catechist from the church to the school cafeteria. During this special time, the volunteers will lead the children through prayers, songs and readings that are simplified for children. The children will learn about the same scripture readings as the rest of the assembly. They will be taught a simplified main message of the readings and are encouraged to share that message with their parents after Mass. The children will return to Mass to sit with their families just before the consecration.
