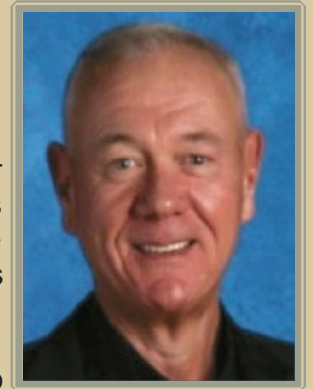

Our Challenge

Dear friends,

In our first reading this weekend from the Book of the Prophet Daniel, the writer wants to console the faithful who are being persecuted for their faith by Antiochus Epiphanes. Daniel is an example of Jewish apocalyptic literature, which uses the dramatic language of vision. The “*Ancient One*” is God, and the “*Son of man*” is the Messianic King. Daniel’s vision of God in his glory has the Son of man receiving dominion over human history. In our New Testament reading from the second letter of St. Peter, he is sharing his memory of Jesus’ mountaintop Transfiguration for those early Christians who might have been questioning the eventual glorification of Jesus’ ultimate triumph. On the “holy mountain” Peter, with his own eyes, had seen Jesus exalted in the same manner that he will be in his final coming. Jesus was no mere mortal, but was God’s own beloved Son, with whom God was well pleased. The extraordinary phenomenon of Jesus’ Transfiguration was witnessed by only three human beings, the disciples Peter, James, and John. This was undeniable verification that Jesus was more than a religious teacher and healer. He was the one who had been anticipated by both the Law (Moses) and the Prophets (Elijah). He was the long-awaited Messiah. Paradox lies at the heart of reality and is expressed to some degree in almost everything. People who cannot embrace paradoxical thinking struggle with understanding the Incarnation. Jesus’ Transfiguration was a dramatic manifestation of the paradox that Jesus was both human and divine, both temporal and eternal. The same Jesus who lived a human life is the eternal Christ who reigns in God’s heavenly realm. Defining God is ultimately impossible. Our best efforts sometimes only create more confusion. Theologians define God as the “*Ground of Being*.” Fr. Thomas Keating refers to God as “*is-ness without limitations*.” Fortunately God chose to accept the limitations of humanity, and of time and space, so that we might experience him in terms we can understand. “*Pontifex Maximus*” is an ancient title for the Pope of the Roman Catholic Church. It means “*Supreme Bridge-builder*.” As the Pope knows well, Jesus Christ is the true *Pontifex Maximus*, who spans the great gulf between heaven and earth so that we might encounter the indefinable God in human terms.
