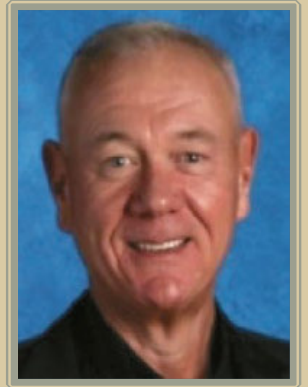

Our Challenge

Dear friends:

The prophet Ezekiel realized that there are ways to life and ways to death. If we follow God's laws we will be lead to life and life in abundance. If, however, we practice wickedness, we are following a path to death. It is never too late to "turn around and go in the opposite direction" to the wholeness of life. St. Paul speaks to the problem of rivalries and disputes within the Church and stresses that only through tolerance and love can they and the Church overcome divisions and bitterness. The parable Jesus tells in our gospel passage this weekend emphasizes first 'what we do' rather than 'what we say.' We may profess over and over how faithful we are, but if these words are not put into action, they are hollow. The passage's second emphasis is that God is interested in what we finally do, not in our mistakes. He gives us many chances to live the life of faith. Many people profess being good Christians. It is one thing to say you are a Christian and another to lead a Christian life. Faith expressed only with words is a dead faith. Jesus is interested in how we lead our lives, not in how we profess our faith. He is interested in how we express our love for one another. God gives people of every age the opportunity to follow a life of faith. He equips us with his grace and calls us to live boldly. The New Testament commands us to forgive as we have been forgiven. This compels me to "do" something. It makes me move toward my enemy into his space. This is the region where God's forgiving love does its most decisive work. This hard work of love moves us into spheres where enemies can meet each other and learn to love and forgive.



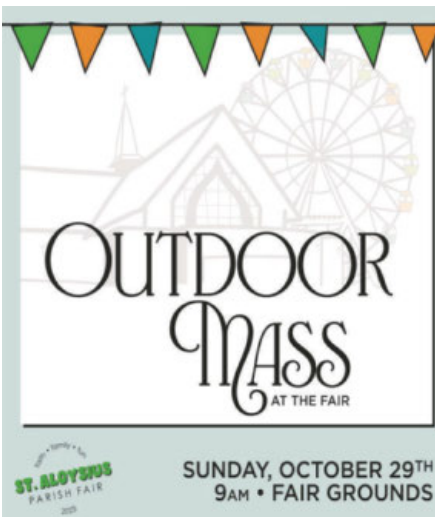

Is Stephen Ministry Calling You?

"A Steady Reminder of God's Presence," remarks a woman tells how having a Stephen Minister during a family crisis gave her a spiritual anchor and the opportunity to focus on her own needs.

This story and many others like this are shared by care receivers voluntarily on the Stephen Ministry website www.stephenministries.org and describes how Stephen Ministry makes a difference in the lives of those who needed this ministry in their communities. Launched in 1975 and headquartered in St. Louis, Missouri, Stephen Ministry now serves 13,000 congregations worldwide, of which St. Aloysius Parish is included. Stephen Ministry is a lay ministry that supplements pastoral care. Trained members provide one-on-one confidential, Christ-centered care to individuals facing a variety of life struggles and transitions, such as grief, chronic illness, job loss, divorce, cancer, or financial difficulties.

Perhaps you are hearing the call to follow God's promises for you by serving as a Stephen Minister. Yes, Stephen Ministry is a time commitment – training hours and visiting care receivers – but you will reap great dividends in the form of graces and blessings through the experiences. The required 50-hour training course begins in January and includes the following dates: January 4th, 11th, 18th, 25th; February 1st, 8th, 22nd, 29th; March 7th, 14th, 21st; and April 4th, 11th. A Commissioning Ceremony is held during Mass after the program ends.


