





Our Challenge

Dear friends:

Like many prominent, highly visible people, the great prophet Jeremiah was the subject of gossip and innuendo. His enemies spread lies to discredit him with the public. Jeremiah was a person of integrity, and his life was an open book. Therefore, he maintained his confidence before God and the people. In our second reading this weekend from St. Paul's letter to the earliest Christians in Rome, he gives us a contrast between sinful humanity, personified in Adam, and



redeemed humanity, personified in Jesus Christ. Evil has been defeated in Jesus' death on the cross, and though we are tempted by sin, we trust in the redeeming power of our Lord Jesus Christ. In this weekend's gospel passage, Jesus gives a picturesque image of God's love and care. His disciples would face many challenges, but he wanted them to trust in God, who cares for creatures as small and common as the sparrow. God would give them the strength to bear a faithful witness. In a superstar culture how much is enough? When we have set the standards of human achievement at the level of extraordinary excellence, how are most of us going to feel good about ourselves? The good news is that in the service of God greatness is not the point. To serve God sufficiently should be our highest aspiration. God's promises have more to do with sufficiency in serving God than with greatness by the world's standards. We live in a menacing world. Not only are there constant threats to our personal safety, but our highest aspirations as Christians are in jeopardy from many sides. Why isn't good enough "good enough"? The values of our culture are clearly in conflict with the life and teachings of Jesus Christ. The chief motivation behind the efforts of people in a "winning is everything" culture is ego-centric. Christ calls us to selfless service in his name. It is not important that we win or succeed for the sake of our own self-aggrandizement. It is important that we serve others in the spirit of Christ. In our service to the kingdom of God our best is always good enough.
