

Celebrating the National Eucharistic Revival

In June 2022, on the Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), the US Council of Catholic Bishops launched a three-year National Eucharistic Revival to respond to Christ's call for us to unite around the source and summit of our faith: the celebration of the Holy Eucharist. The first year of the Revival focused on the local diocese and invited diocesan staff, bishops, and priests to respond to the Lord's personal invitation and equipped them to share this love with the faithful through eucharistic congresses and events.

The second phase of the National Eucharistic Revival will begin Sunday June 11, the Feast of Corpus Christi, and focus on fostering devotion at the parish level. In the coming year at St. Aloysius we will strengthen our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, resources, preaching, and organic movements of the Holy Spirit. Specific plans in our parish include once-monthly Tuesday evening Eucharistic Adoration with reverent music, the distribution of copies of Bishop Robert Barron's *This is My Body*, a fall Eucharist study entitled "Jesus and the Eucharist," and speakers on the Real Presence. This promises to be a wonderful holy year!

Our Challenge

Dear friends,

In the Book of Deuteronomy, the thought is on the meaning of hardship which Israel suffered in the wilderness. This, too, is an example of God's providence. It was God's means of humbling the nation. Teaching them their utter dependence on Him, rather than on themselves. In our second reading, St. Paul is saying that Jesus was comparing old traditions to the new sacrament of his body and blood. Just as an unbreakable bond was forged between two men if they ate each other's

bread and salt, so a sacrificial meal formed a real communion between God and His worshipper. The new revelation of God in Jesus Christ is confirmed in the sacrament of Holy Communion. It is an offering of Christ to each of us and in partaking of the sacrament we have the promise that we, who eat this bread, will live forever. Receiving the sacrament of Holy Communion is not just something that we do. It is something that changes us. We are taking in the life and love of Christ into our being when we receive the bread and blood of Christ. We need to be mindful of the holiness of this sacrament. We cannot enjoy the pleasures of life while ignoring the problems of others. The sacrament of Holy Communion binds us together with Christ. It is in and with the strength of Jesus that we are able to do incredible and loving works as servants of God. Let us be mindful every time we receive Communion of the sacrifice of God's love for us, so that we use His precious gift for the good of others.
