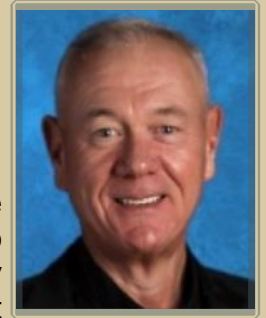
Our Challenge

Dear friends,

The prophet Zephaniah promised the Israelites that God would remove the judgment against them and turn away their enemies. They were powerless to return to Jerusalem on their own and restore their land. But God is a mighty savior who will renew his people in joy and love. St. Paul assured the earliest Christians at Philippi, Greece, that God was present to help in time of trouble. He urged them to dismiss all anxiety from their minds and to present their needs to God in prayer. He said God's own peace would stand guard over their hearts and minds, lending help when they needed it. John the Baptist pointed to the coming Messiah as the true source of salvation. He called people to repent, to turn away from trying to justify themselves. John knew that the people would be transformed only by God. None of us can save ourselves from the wages of sin and death. Sociologist Philip Rieff wrote an important book titled *The Triumph of the Therapeutic* in which he described an axial shift in our culture. Narcissism has become a key theme in our culture, and psychotherapy has replaced religion. Is this turn toward self-development and self-fulfillment a challenge to faith or not? We all hunger for newness of life. We spend enormous time, energy, and money on improving ourselves. But we can only find the newness of life that we seek from God. A well-known saying is that the lawyer who pleads his or her own case has a fool for a client. We lack the objectivity to represent ourselves in a court of law fairly and wisely. By the same token, the person who tries to redeem himself or herself has a fool for a disciple. We lack the wisdom and the discipline to fashion a new life by our own unaided effort. We need help from above to achieve the full and true humanity we are seeking.

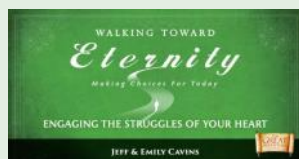

Coming to St. Aloysius in February-March 2022!

Throughout our lives we confront countless obstacles that aggravate us, discourage us, and damage our relationships with Christ and one another. Finding time to address them is often overshadowed by the hectic pace of everyday demands. How can we slow down, identify the struggles, and open our hearts to God's gracious direction?

"Engaging the Struggles of Your Heart," part of the Ascension Press *"Walking Toward Eternity"* series, is a challenging study that will open our eyes to stumbling-blocks in our Christian path, such as disordered desires, shame, envy, anger, fear, loneliness, and hopelessness. Through listening to one another and opening our hearts to the healing grace of the Holy Spirit, we will begin to engage these struggles in a positive way and continue toward our goal of union with Christ.

Each session in the 8-week series will involve prayer, conversation, and a video presentation that includes teaching and testimony by Catholics who have struggled with the various obstacles we will consider.
