

#### PRAYER FOR MOTHERS


Heavenly Father,

## **Our Challenge**

Dear friends.

In our first reading this weekend from the Acts of the Apostles, Philip must have felt alone when he went on a preaching mission to a strange town in a foreign land. He knew he would meet the opposition of rivals and the indifference of people. But Philip was never lonely because he knew that Christ traveled with him and worked through him. The early Christians lived under a constant threat. The Christian way was a rival to the established religion and politics of the day. But in



this weekend's second reading, St. Peter reassured his readers that Christ was with them in the midst of persecution and rejection. They were never alone, even when everyone stood against them. Jesus did his best to prepare his disciples for his coming death. He assured them that God's Spirit would be with them to comfort and guide them. But he also promised them that someday they would all be together in the world to come. More than half a century ago David Riesman published a sociological study of modern society entitled *The Lonely Crowd*. Riesman uncovered the central paradox of modern life. We have never lived closer together or been farther apart. A vast, untold number of us live lonely lives, even though we are constantly surrounded by multitudes of people. Probably more people than we imagine live isolated lives. Either their jobs take them to remote places or their circumstances cut them off from other people. But people who live alone will not be lonely if they belong to God and the people of God. Loneliness is more a state of mind than a location in space. We can be in the crush of a crowd and still feel lonely. We can be a hundred miles from another human being and still feel close. When we carry love in our hearts, we are never alone. Those we love and those who love us are a part of every thought we have, of every word we speak, of every deed we do.
