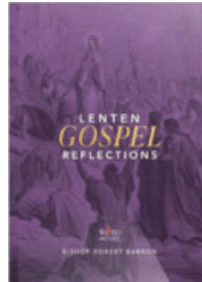
Families of the sick are encouraged to contact the Pastoral Services Center at 343-6657. Communion is brought to the sick weekly. Hospital visits are also made weekly.

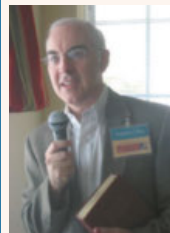

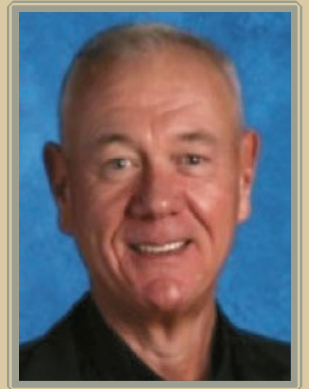

## Our Challenge

Dear friends,

In this weekend's Old Testament passage from the Book of Deuteronomy, we're reminded that the children of Israel were given the laws of God through Moses during their wilderness wanderings. Moses was God's prophet to speak God's words of judgment and promise. It is an awesome assignment to speak on behalf of God. The Apostle Paul held up daunting challenges for the earliest Christian Churches he founded and to whom he wrote his letters, partially because he believed Christ would return soon. Though his timetable was wrong, Paul's priorities were right. We need to be committed to God's kingdom above all else. In the evangelist Mark's gospel passage this weekend, we hear that in the synagogue at Capernaum the people were impressed with the authority with which Jesus taught. Even the demon-possessed man recognized Jesus as someone who had come from God. Jesus healed the man, which further influenced the people to see him as an extraordinary person. His fame spread quickly. Fame is highly valued in our "star" struck culture. Many people envy those who seem to have it all - - adulation, economic power, influence. We often fail to see the price these people pay for their popularity. We also fail to notice when the fame subsides and the star fades. The public is fickle. Today's powerful may be tomorrow's victims. Most of us have more power than we realize. Nearly everyone can influence others for good or ill. Some people are entrusted with special kinds of authority and can make a substantial difference in the world. Jesus was a rising star when he appeared on the scene. Everywhere he went people were impressed with what he said and what he did. Throughout Galilee his fame spread like wildfire. The crowds became so large that he had to hide in order to rest and pray. In fact, the story of Jesus involves an incredible backlash. It is difficult to find another historical figure whose public infamy turned so quickly and so completely. But Jesus had not come seeking power and influence, and he remained true to his mission all the way to its costly but victorious end. Our challenge is to not seek fame as much as faithfulness.
