- A person who loves and respects the local wedding customs.** A person who understands the etiquette, fashion and social norms connected with weddings.

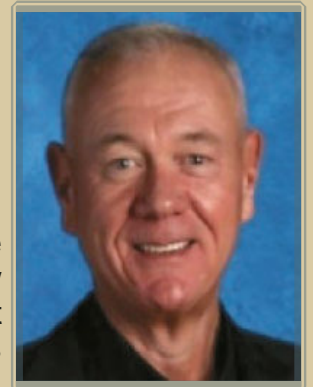

Our Challenge

Dear friends:

The miracle of Pentecost was not simply that people from various parts of the world heard the disciples speaking in their own native languages, but that a new era was breaking forth. The Spirit and presence of God was being revealed, not just to the Jews, but to the whole world, ultimately to include people of all times and places. Everyone has some distinctive gift with which to make a difference in the world. The secret of a truly good life is understanding what you have to contribute to life. We are not judged by how much we achieve but by how well we use our gifts for the sake of others and a better world. The word "worth" may have two very different references or meanings. We can use the word "worth" to talk both about money or about morality. We can talk about the work of a person in terms of their possessions or their character. The profit motive may drive the economy, but only the moral motive can build the world. We are often troubled by things that happen because our understanding of those events is not complete. The better understanding we have of people and circumstances, the more we can get from, and give to, life. The late German psychotherapist Victor Frankl developed a theory about those who survived the Holocaust. The people who were able to overcome the horror and brutality of the death camps were individuals who had some explanation of what was happening to them. In simply understanding what was happening to them gave them a miraculous power to endure hardships beyond imagining. The Bible says that human understanding can be enlarged by the Spirit of God. This does not mean that we can earn a Ph.D. if we welcome the Spirit into our lives! It means that the Spirit of God enlarges our capacity to experience the world in all of both its complexity and grandeur.

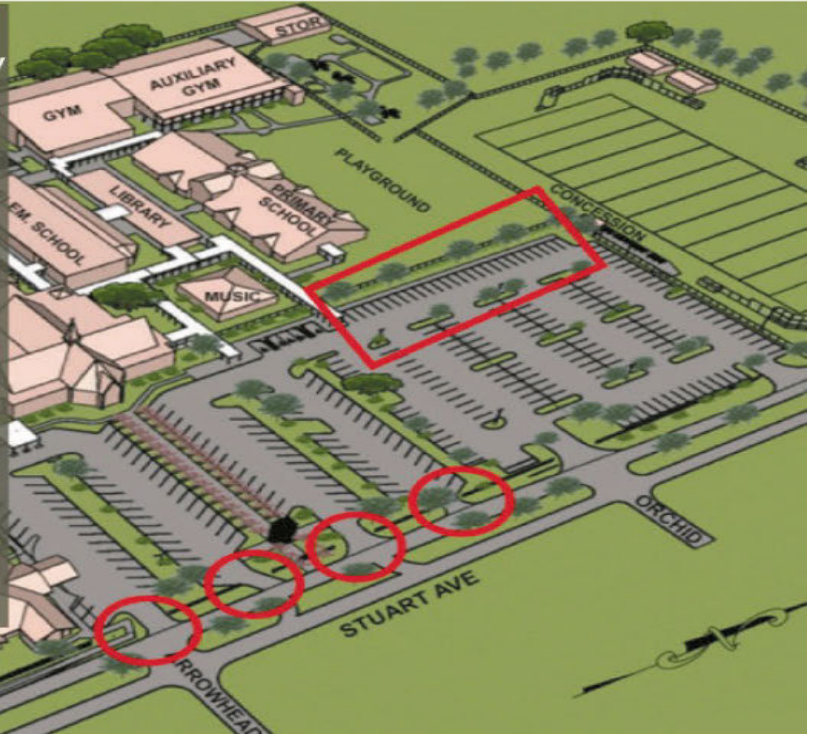
