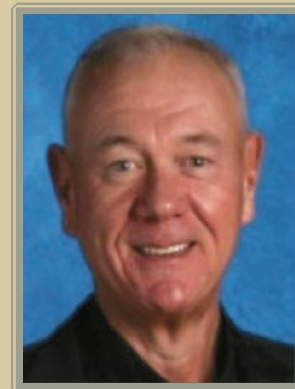

Our Challenge

Dear friends:

We contrast love and law. This weekend's first reading is the Exodus story of God giving his people the ten commandments. God's law was a gift love to them. This is not difficult to understand when we consider that we do the same thing for our children. Our rules are sometimes a 'bitter pill to swallow' for them, but one day they will understand that our rules were given as an act of love. In our second reading from St. Paul's first letter to the earliest Christians in Corinth, Greece, he reflects that he was anything but naïve about the ways of the world. He knew how the world deified power and wisdom, and understood what these words meant in the world of rulers and the ruled. He drew a mighty contrast between those views and the power and wisdom of God, which we see in Christ. Our gospel passage this weekend reflects that zeal for the holiness of God's house caused Jesus to react in anger that it was being used in such an ungodly and unscrupulous way. Money-changers in the temple were taking advantage of the poor and trusting worshipers. Jesus said they made God's house a den of thieves and drove them out. Popular words in our culture today are "power" and "wisdom." Political and economic power are seen as the supreme good, and wisdom is prized to the extent that it enhances and increases our power. St. Paul saw Christ as both the power and the wisdom of God. The culture's meaning and Paul's meaning are worlds apart. It has always been a temptation for people to see in Jesus only what he might do for them. We want healing from Jesus. We want forgiveness, empowerment, etc. But a more objective look reveals what a model Jesus is in terms of human character. Language is tricky. The same word may have several meanings, and not all of them compatible with each other. We praise "strength," but are we referring to body building or character building? No word is used with more meanings than the word "love." How strange, that we use the same word to describe how we feel about God and about chocolate! "Power" and "wisdom" are best-defined in the person of Jesus Christ, but we must be careful to let Christ define these important words, and not the other way around.
