


# ANNIVERSARY & RETIREMENT CELEBRATION



## **Our Challenge**

#### Dear friends:

In our first reading this weekend from the Acts of the Apostles, the boldness of Simon Peter is remarkable. Often, he responded abruptly and inappropriately, but he matured. Here he uses the healing of a crippled man to confront the religious leaders who had been responsible for the crucifixion, saying it was in Jesus' name that the man was healed. In our second reading from the first letter of St. John, we hear that Jesus called God "Father" because he had come from God and because of his intimacy with God. John claims that God's love is such that we are called



God's children. This is who we are now, and we will grow spiritually into the fullness of life as we see it in Jesus Christ. Jesus used many ways to explain our relationship with God. Jesus identified himself as the good shepherd. There were many threats to flocks of sheep, and a mere hired man might not protect them. The good shepherd, however, cares for the sheep in every way, even to the point of laying down his life. The actor Peter Sellers was able to play an extremely wide range of parts. His biographer, Peter Evans (*The Mask Behind the Mask*), says Sellers played so many roles he was sometimes not sure of his own identity. Once he was approached by a fan who asked, "Are you Peter Sellers?" Sellers said, "Not today," and walked on. The suffering in our world can be understood largely in terms of mistaken identities. When we do not know who we are, we are orphans in the world. When we know we are children of God, we begin to live the abundant life Christ came to give us. John Steinbeck, Pulitzer Prize winning novelist, said that most people do not like themselves at all. "They quarrel and boast and pretend and are jealous because they do not like themselves." What could be more tragic? Such people have forgotten, or do not know, their true origins. They are beautiful and good creations of a loving God, in whose very image they are made.


