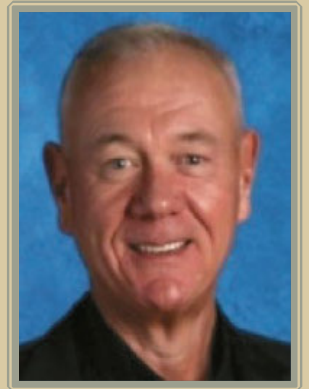

Our Challenge

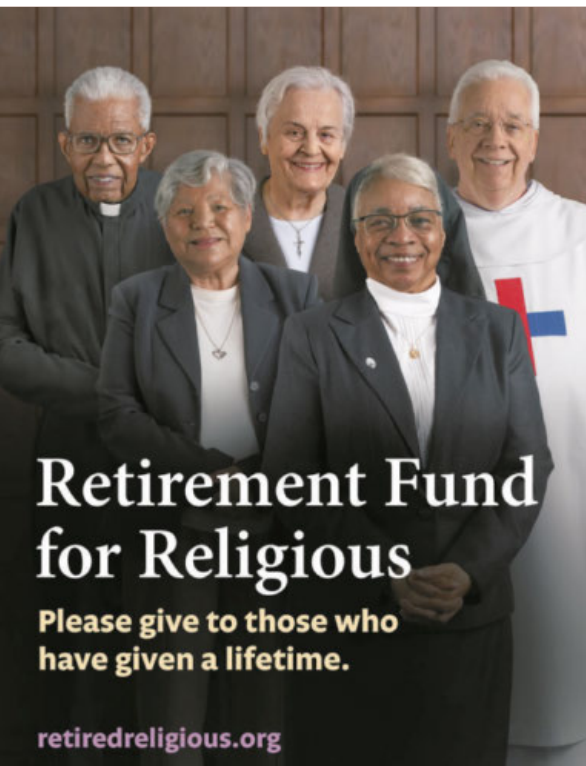
Dear friends,

In our Old Testament reading this weekend, the prophet Isaiah proclaimed that God was at work in the people's experiences. He challenged them to prepare for the great things God would do. The focus was not on when God would act, or how, but on the people being prepared for it. As humans, we live within time. God is eternal and the Creator of time. God does not measure time as we do. We must not question God's timing but trust in God's wisdom and love. Christians live in the promise of Christ's ultimate victory. God always sends messengers to prepare the people for what God is about to do. Preparation for what is coming is important, even if we do not know when it will come. There is always a voice calling us to get our lives in order and prepare for the coming of the Lord. Like children, we sometimes wonder why we have to wait for the things we want, especially from God. Why does God not respond to our prayers? Often the reason is that God knows we are not ready to receive what we are waiting for. Like a good parent, God is loving and patient. God knows when we are ready. In the times when we are waiting for God to act or to respond, we must ask what God would have us do. The work of God's kingdom is often done in times of waiting. Of all human responsibilities, what is more important or comprehensive than the stewardship of time? Each of us has time in limited supply and none of us knows how much we will have. Times of waiting need not be wasted time. The person of faith can use times of waiting redemptively - - to work, to pray, and to rest.

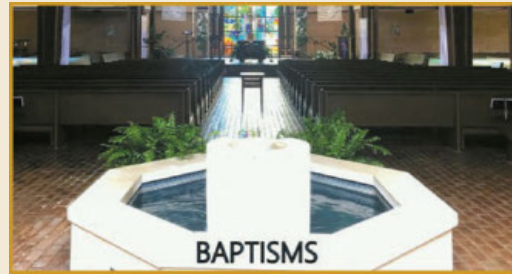

The Sacrament of Confirmation completes the grace of Baptism, more perfectly binds one to the Church, and enriches one with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Are you a baptized Catholic who has received the Sacraments of First Communion and First Reconciliation, is out of high school, but has not received the Sacrament of Confirmation? Contact [Deacon Chauvin](#) and he will send you an application packet which should be completed and returned soon. Adult Confirmation classes will be held from **6:30-8 PM** on **February 5, February 19, March 4, March 18, March 25, April 15, and April 22, 2024**. Presently, the class meetings are scheduled to be at St. Aloysius in the Edith Stein Room of Gonzaga Hall. Your sponsor must be a confirmed and practicing Catholic in good standing with the Church.
