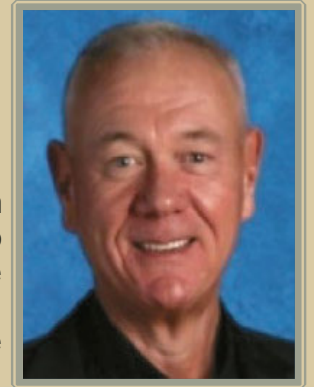

Our Challenge



Dear friends:

The prophet Ezekiel places an emphasis on the individual's responsibility in helping to establish the spiritual life of the community. Each individual is also responsible for helping to maintain good relationships between all members of the society. St. Paul makes it clear that we need to love our neighbors as ourselves. This love does not allow us to hold on to our hurts or nurture grudges. We are compelled to seek reconciliation in the name of love. Jesus did not want us to feel victimized. When we are wronged, he expects us to take the initiative to restore the relationship. It is often very difficult in certain situations NOT to feel as though we have been victimized. So many things in our lives seem to be beyond our control. There is no greater hurt than the hurt inflicted by the people we care about. Often we tend to shun those who have hurt us rather than seeking reconciliation. This, however, only prolongs the hurt. Jesus realized that many of us feel victimized by life. We feel that those who have wronged us have the responsibility to initiate forgiveness. However, Christ wanted us to have life and to have it abundantly. Therefore, Jesus puts the responsibility of reconciliation on the victim's shoulders. Only in this way can our wounds be healed.

“Jesus and the Eucharist:” An Invitation to Renewal!



Beginning **Thursday, September 21, at 6:00 PM** in the **Parish Hall, St. Aloysius Church** will be offering a unique opportunity to reflect and experience renewal in our devotion to God’s gift of Himself in the Holy Eucharist.

Every parish across the country is being invited to host “**Jesus and the Eucharist,**” a seven-part video study that serves as a key element in our on-going National Eucharistic Revival. The study offers a short-course in the Catholic Faith, focusing on the **Biblical Story of Salvation**, the **Identity of Jesus**, the **Gift of Salvation**, the

Importance of the Church, and the **Life-giving Treasure of the Most Blessed Sacrament**.

Each session opens with an exhortation from a different U.S. Catholic bishop, followed by *lectio divina* prayer with Scripture. Each lesson is drawn from content created by the **Augustine Institute** (producers of **FORMED.org**) and will include personal testimonies from Catholics across the country. We will then transition into small group discussions. Each session will be 2 hours or less.

The series is **free**, but we do need you to register so that we will have enough materials available for all participants. Also, we are planning to provide childcare for ages 1-5 in the Child Care Center, so we will need to know how many children to expect each evening. Finally, we’re looking for volunteers to facilitate the discussions in the small groups. Worksheets and questions will be provided!

Children’s Church is a great opportunity for adults and middle school/high school youth to volunteer and help eager youngsters learn the Word of the Lord. Children’s Church is an age-appropriate Liturgy of the Word offered for children in PreK through 2nd grade at most 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM Masses. No pre-registration is necessary. All children are welcome and encouraged to attend. Just before the Liturgy of the Word begins for the assembly, the celebrant will invite the children to gather at the altar, receive a blessing, and then follow the catechist from the church to the school cafeteria. During this special time, the volunteers will lead the children through prayers, songs and readings that are simplified for children. The children will learn about the same scripture readings as the rest of the assembly. They will be taught a simplified main message of the readings and are encouraged to share that message with their parents after Mass. The children will return to Mass to sit with their families just before the consecration.

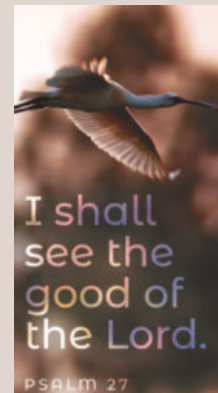

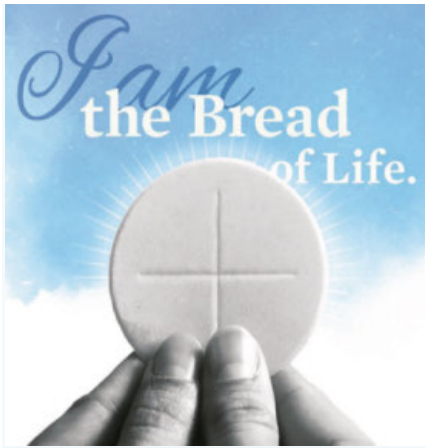


