Our Challenge

Dear friends:

The prophet Isaiah felt completely unworthy when confronted with God's holiness. He was utterly surprised that God wanted to use him. The vision in the temple was simply overwhelming. Isaiah discovered that those God calls, God equips. God purged Isaiah's lips and transformed his heart. St. Paul is sometimes seen as self-confident to the point of arrogance. But in this weekend's second reading we see his sense of unworthiness regarding his calling. He sees himself as "*the least of the apostles,*" and "*unfit*" to be an apostle. He attributes his spiritual status to the grace of God, "*By the grace of God, I am what I am.*" Simon Peter is a disciple to whom we all can relate. He was often impatient and easily discouraged. When he had worked all night and caught no fish he was ready to quit. He followed Jesus' instructions, however, and made the catch of his life! Christ is the Lord of second chances. There is a difference between working to live and living to work. Working to live provides the resources we need to *survive* in this world. Living to work furnishes us the satisfaction we need to *thrive* in this world. Fortunate are those whose work both provides their livelihood and fulfills their lives. Feelings of unworthiness cripple more lives than we know. Low self-esteem keeps some people from taking the initiative necessary for successful pursuits. We all have opportunities to encourage other people, and often our influence is more important than we realize. The same materials and labor can build a chapel or a brothel. We have some choice in where to invest our efforts and how to use our skills. Even if we cannot choose our work, we can do our best to make it a hymn of praise to God who created all things and saw that they were good.

FIRST RECONCILIATION NEWS

Parents will have a choice in choosing when their child will receive their First Reconciliation:

Option 1: Our communal celebration of First Reconciliation with priests to assist Fr. Randy Cuevas will be on **Saturday, February 5, 2022, at 10:00 AM** in the church. Parents and First Reconciliation Candidates attend this event.

Parents may be present but won't be seated with the children. 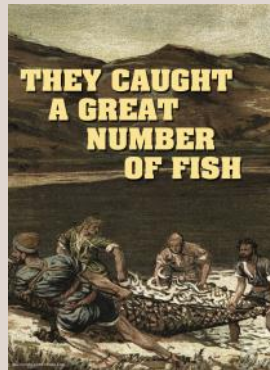
