






St. Aloysius at The Holy Grill

Our Challenge

Dear friends,

Our first reading this weekend from the fifth chapter of the Acts of the Apostles is part of the larger narrative of the initial missionary adventures of Peter and John in Jerusalem after Jesus' ascension. It is bracketed literally by two key summary



descriptions of the new community devoted to teaching: fellowship and the breaking of bread. The verses from our second reading from the Book of Revelation give praise to the Lamb. Many angels, the four living creatures, and the elders once again sing with a loud voice. Our passage from John's gospel has the disciples returning to work as fishermen and discovering that Jesus is waiting for them. They are astonished and find that he gives what they need in abundance. Joseph Bessler wrote that "neither understanding nor action alone constitutes authentic faith, and thus one needs to unite the best of Peter and the best of John if one is to be a person of true faith." Feelings tend to be momentary and changeable, yet it is sometimes impossible to completely ignore them. Peter was very impulsive when he jumped out of the boat to greet Jesus. John was thoughtful in his recognition of who the stranger was, and St. John Chrysostom observed, "When they recognized Jesus, the disciples Peter and John again exhibited their different temperaments. The one was fervent, the other more contemplative. The one was ready to go, the other more penetrating. John is the one who first recognized Jesus, but Peter is the first to come to him."
