



Our Challenge

Dear friends:

In this weekend's passage from the Book of Amos, the prophet confronted the Israelites with their failure to remember their lessons from the past. Living in luxury put them at odds with the God who champions the poor, the homeless, and the captives. God will send judgment on those who despise justice and mercy.



The Apostle Paul instructed young pastor Timothy in the things that really matter - - moral character, integrity, faith, love, and patience. Paul reminded the young man of his conversion and his calling, and his commitment to God. In this weekend's gospel passage, Jesus' parable of the rich man and Lazarus dramatically demonstrates how economic wealth can blind people to their spiritual poverty. The rich man refused to see that true security came from faith in God, not from financial assets and luxurious living. Why do the wicked prosper? This question has been asked in every generation. Implied in this question is another question: Why don't the righteous prosper? There are no simple answers. A different set of reasons lies behind each person's "lot" in life. The challenge is not to answer "why," but to do what we can to help the poor. It is impossible to remove entirely the human interest in being rewarded for good deeds or for exemplary behavior. When good people appear to be unrewarded in this life, we take comfort in the thought that they will be rewarded in the life to come. Rewards, whether here or in heaven, are seldom on the minds of genuinely good people. They help someone because they are moved by their need, or simply because it is the right thing to do. Doing good by helping others is its own reward.


