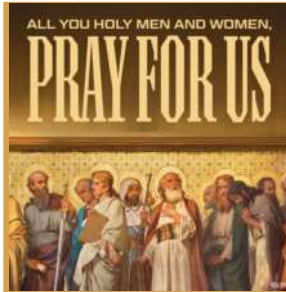

- State State CYLA Chairman, Delmas Forbes, will email the top 5 in each division.

- If you are selected as the Council winner, your local Knights of Columbus Council will notify you.
- Councils submit their winners to the State by February 7, 2026.

- Everyone invited will win a cash prize between \$1,000 and \$5,000!

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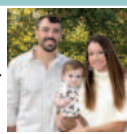


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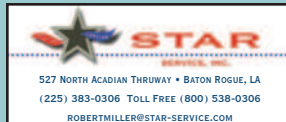
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
