




40 Hour Eucharistic Adoration Devotion



Our Challenge

Dear friends:

Who could blame the early Christians for having doubts about Saul? He had persecuted them relentlessly and tried to destroy the Church. But Barnabas, who had welcomed Saul to his home, convinced the apostles that Paul had been changed by an encounter with the risen Christ on the road to Damascus. The test of a genuine religious conversion is the life of the convert. We can be sure that God is with us if we love one another. We cannot 'will' or 'pretend' love for either friends



or enemies. Only the transforming power of Jesus Christ can fill our hearts with such love. Christians live a transformed life by drawing strength and resolve from Christ himself. He is the true vine and gives life to the branches and produces the fruits of the spirit. Love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, and kindness are the gifts we receive from Christ. We are fascinated with few things more than dramatic changes in people's lives. What accounts for a successful person's downward spiral into darkness and failure? How does an apparent loser rise to the level of significant achievement? Every situation is different, but most stories of change have a spiritual component. We often give up too quickly on difficult cases. We keep our distance from outcasts and failures. Jesus ate and drank with sinners. He identified with the oppressed. He reached out to the rejected. He welcomed all. In God's sight, there are no hopeless cases. The addicted can be set free from drugs. The criminal can be liberated from lawlessness. The abuser can turn away from violence. The racist can be set free from hate. The alienated can be restored. Liberation and recovery may be difficult, time-consuming, and discouraging, but God holds out the promise of change for everyone who wants to change.
