- A person who loves and respects the local wedding customs.** A person who understands the etiquette, fashion and social norms connected with weddings.

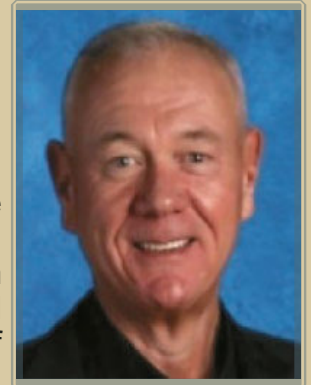

## Our Challenge

Dear friends:

The Evangelist Luke is attributed authorship of the book of the Acts of the Apostles. He begins with his account of Jesus' Ascension. After his crucifixion, the resurrected Christ appeared repeatedly to his followers and taught them concerning the kingdom of God. He reiterated the promise of the Holy Spirit and commanded them to wait for this empowerment before they began their mission of taking the gospel throughout the world. In our second reading this weekend, St. Paul gives thanks for the Christians in Ephesus and for their faith in the risen Christ. He prays that they may have the spirit of wisdom and a growing knowledge of Jesus Christ. He then paints a vivid verbal picture of the triumphant Christ who rules in the heavenly places over all other powers and reigns over all things for the sake of his Church, which is his Body. After Jesus instructed his apostles to make disciples of all nations and baptize them and teach them to observe everything he had commanded them, they descended the mountain in expectation and hope, not in grief, as they had some 40 days earlier. Christ had entrusted them with his saving mission to preach, teach, and baptize. He promised to be with them always in this mission and to give them the very power of his Holy Spirit. They were not to be orphans, but his witnesses to the ends of the earth. Jesus' last words before his Ascension probably seemed like a mixed message to his disciples. On the one hand, he told them they would be his witnesses "to the ends of the earth." On the other hand, he told them to stay in Jerusalem and wait. It was not the first time the disciples were confused by Jesus' words. Neither was it the first time Jesus' confusing words turned out to be full of wisdom and truth. In celebrating the Ascension we proclaim the exaltation of Jesus Christ by God the Father. In the heavenly realm Christ has been granted all power and authority on behalf of his Church. The disciples of Jesus kept thinking they had reached the end of their life with him. When he died on the cross, they fell into despair knowing that all was lost. When he ascended into heaven, they were bewildered and felt bereft. Our challenge is to remember that Pentecost brought the gift of Christ's Spirit as a living and powerful presence in their lives. From that time forward, until the end of their lives, they discovered that Jesus' promise to be with them was true, and they faced life and death assured of an ultimate reunion with him in heaven.

### St. Aloysius Parishioner to be Ordained to Permanent Diaconate is Assigned to St. Aloysius!



Bishop Duca has assigned Don Allison to augment our St. Aloysius clergy after his upcoming ordination to the Permanent Diaconate on August 12, 2023. Don is a native of Pineville, Louisiana, and a graduate of the University of Louisiana at Monroe. He and his wife of 41 years, Beth, a native of New Iberia, have lived in Baton Rouge all of their married life, and have been parishioners at St. Aloysius for the past 5 years. They have three daughters, two sons-in-law, and three grandsons. Their daughter Ashley Bugea, her husband John, and their three sons are parishioners at St. Aloysius.

The three sons, Charlie, John Luke, and Thomas are completing 8<sup>th</sup> grade, 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, respectively, here at St. Aloysius School. Don and Beth's daughter Amber lives in McMinnville, Oregon. Their daughter Aubrey and her husband Adam Waggenspack live in New Orleans.

Don was not Catholic while growing up, and he went through the RCIA process in 1983-84. After a 40+ year career as a CPA, business consultant, and governmental affairs professional, Don retired in August 2019. In 2017, Don felt a calling to explore the diaconate and the process of becoming a deacon. After doing so, Don decided to take the next step and entered the diaconate formation program in the summer of 2018. Don has now completed the five-year diaconate formation program, and will be ordained by Bishop Duca at 10:00 AM, on Saturday, August 12, 2023, at St. Joseph Cathedral. His assignment as Deacon Assistant at St. Aloysius will be effective on Monday, August 14, 2023. Additionally, his assigned Ministry of Charity will be to serve the needs of prisoners throughout the Diocese of Baton Rouge.

We heartily welcome Deacon Don to our St. Aloysius Church staff, and look forward to his ministry among us, along with the continued ministry of Deacon Chauvin, who has been assigned to St. Aloysius since 2013.

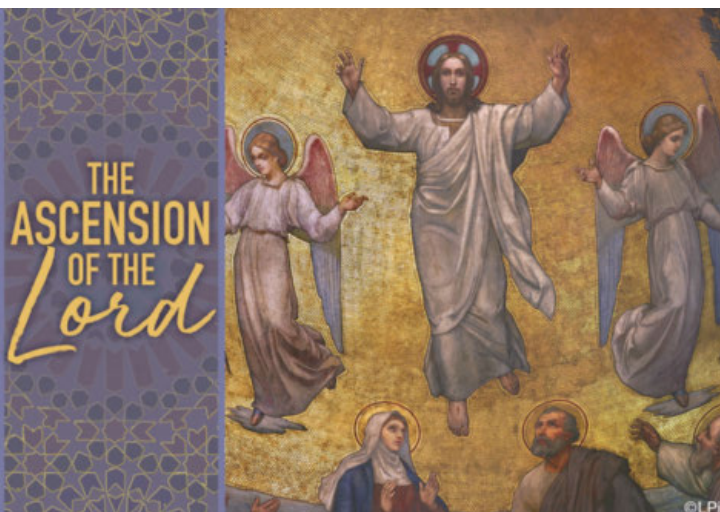
