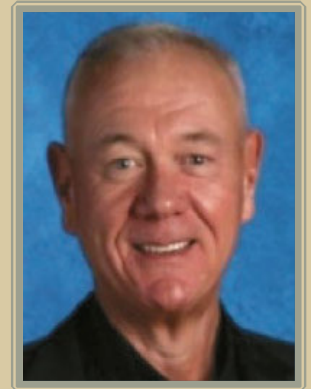

Our Challenge

Dear friends:

It is not uncommon in the Old Testament for the enemies of Israel to be used by God in accomplishing some purpose. This is what we see in this weekend's Old Testament reading. The pagan emperor Cyrus promised to rebuild the temple in Jerusalem for the Jews who had been carried captive into Babylon. This was a very surprising turn of events! In our passage from St. Paul's letter to the earliest Christians in Ephesus, Turkey, he claims we are God's workmanship. Being rich in mercy, and loving us greatly, God delivered us from spiritual death. We have been raised together with Christ and will share in his glorious future. We are saved by grace, and by grace have become God's workmanship, that we might do good works. In our gospel passage this weekend, Nicodemus' visit to Jesus became the occasion for John the evangelist to wax eloquently on the incredible love of God. God loved the world so much that God's own Son was sent into the world to redeem the world. Christ did not come to condemn the world, but that the world might be redeemed through him. As a rule, we Westerners are not comfortable with mystery. Easterners embrace mystery more easily, even naturally. Biblical faith comes to us from the East. Jesus spoke easily and often of the mystery of the Spirit. Jesus told Nicodemus that the Spirit is as mysterious as the wind. We don't know where it comes from or where it is going. The Holy Spirit is often defined as "God present to our spirits." The Holy Spirit is uniquely related to the Christian community in its various expressions. The Holy Spirit empowers Christ's Church to do the work of worship, ministry, and reconciliation. The life of faith is full of mystery. How could it be otherwise? We live on a miniscule orb in an infinite universe. We understand very little of reality or of God. Mysteries abound, first, because we are so small and finite. Mysteries abound, second, because God is the Beyond. Mystery is God's realm and God is love.
