Dr. Christopher DeCock is a clinical professor of Pediatrics at University of North Dakota School of Medicine and Health Sciences and practices pediatric neurology and epilepsy at Essentia Health in Fargo, ND. He holds an MS in Bloethics from the University of Mary and serves as the Co-Chair of Essentia's West Market ethics committee. Dr. DeCock currently serves as an Observer for the Uniform Law Commission's Drafting Committee on the Revision for the Uniform Determination of Death Act. 
