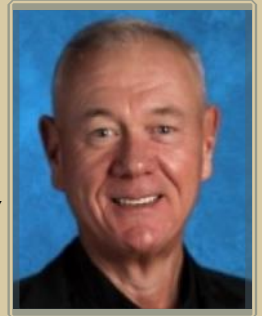

Our Challenge

Dear friends:

Words have often changed the course of history. In the Old Testament, Joshua presented the assembled children of Israel with a fateful choice: *“Decide today whom you will serve. But for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.”* This ringing challenge brought the people to their knees before the Lord God. St. Paul challenged believers to make Jesus Christ the norm by which they lived. This means following Christ’s commandments and emulating his actions. Husbands and wives are to defer to each other with a love like that between Christ and his Church: mutual love, mutual sacrifice. The Gospel of John records Jesus’ startling interpretation of his role in the lives of his followers. Eating his flesh and drinking his blood were unacceptable ideas to some, who turned from following him. Those who stayed knew of no other teacher who had the words of eternal life. We prize individualism, but we are dependent on other people every day, from birth through death. For automobile repairs, we need a mechanic. For legal questions, we need a lawyer. For illnesses and injuries, we need a doctor. But where do we go with our questions and concerns about ultimate things? To whom *can* we go but to Jesus? Our world measures value in terms of power, wealth, and fame, but pursuing these ends fails to produce the meaningful lives we are seeking. The alternative of following Christ, however, brings us the fulfillment for which we are created. The disciples asked, *“Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.”* Psychology has shown us that we are so desperate for answers that any answer is often preferable to no answer. The irrational beliefs and superstitious ideas that fill so many minds are evidence that people will cling to absurdities out of fear of the emptiness and silence of the universe. Christians have found in Christ an answer that holds up against human doubts and griefs. He has the words of eternal life.

Register now for The Upcoming Adult Formation Study Beginning Mid September: *“Oremus: A Guide to Catholic Prayer”*

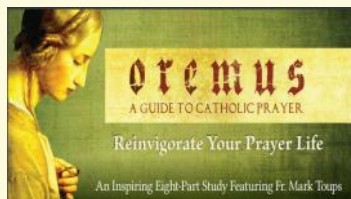
Beginning in mid-September, small groups will explore and experience the rich tradition of Catholic prayer through the Ascension Press study, *“Oremus: A Guide to Catholic Prayer,”* by Fr. Mark Toups. Spanning eight weeks, *Oremus* (Latin for *“let us pray”*) teaches the essentials of an effective and fruitful prayer life and guides participants through the simple yet profound steps of Catholic prayer. Following Church tradition and the wisdom of the Saints, we will learn to talk to God and hear His voice in Scripture, in the heart, and in ordinary moments. We will become more aware of God’s presence, will learn to overcome distractions and dryness, and will recognize desolation and consolation as normal prayer experiences. And as we grow closer to God, we will also grow in our relationship with those around us.

Sessions include: **What is Prayer?; Before You Pray; Praying with Scripture; Relational Prayer; Spiritual Senses; Discernment; Dealing with Distractions; Desolation and Consolation**

Study groups are being organized to meet both online and in-person for this eight-week study.

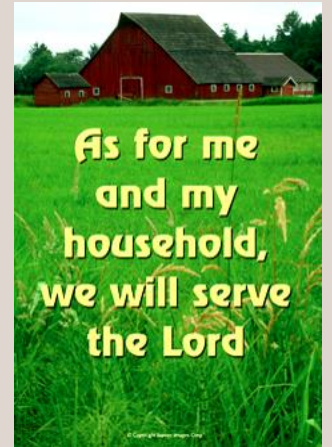

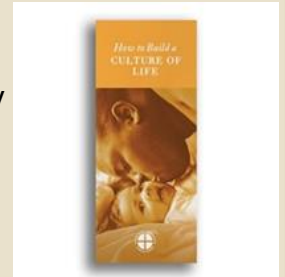


