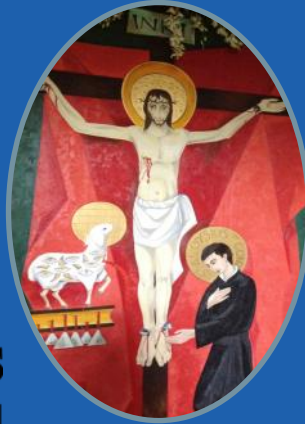

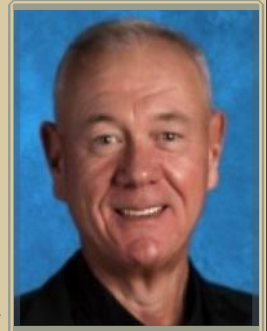
Our Challenge

Dear friends,

In our first reading this weekend from the Book of the Prophet Habakkuk, he begged for deliverance from the violence, destruction, and misery around him. God did not promise immediate deliverance, but told him to have faith in the vision of peace and prosperity and that He would be with him always. In our second reading from St. Paul's second letter to the bishop Timothy, he reminded Timothy that God's Spirit is not cowardly, but brings strength, wisdom and love into our lives. But these gifts don't work against our will or without our effort. Only when we are willing to endure life's hardships, do we discover the joys that accompany them. Our Christian walk does not always promise deliverance from life's trials. The apostles asked Jesus to increase their faith, but Jesus' response was that they needed to exercise the faith they had. Even a small faith when put to use can grow into a faith strong enough to move mountains. We all love success stories. We read about them and our hearts are affirmed. But what about the many times that we fail in life or life fails us; when we pray for deliverance physically or emotionally and deliverance doesn't come? What do we do then? We have all suffered times when we felt completely abandoned, and felt our prayers were not answered. We have prayed for deliverance and it didn't come, and we've wondered why. Our faith is like Timothy's – weak and wavering. William Coleridge once said, *"Never yet did there exist a full faith in the divine word which did not expand the intellect while it purified the heart."* The stronger our faith in God, the clearer our vision, and the more empowered we become to overcome when deliverance doesn't come.

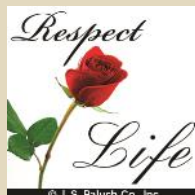
