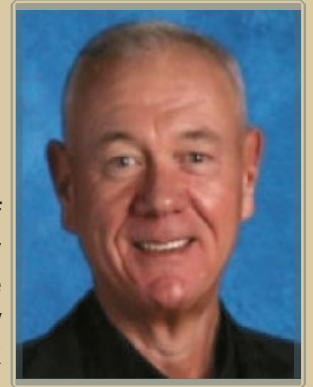

Our Challenge

Dear friends,

The early Christians were filled with courage. They let nothing stand in the way of their mission to spread the gospel far and wide. When problems arose, they solved them. When leaders were needed, they created them. They had the courage to do new things to solve old problems. There were many in the early church who stumbled and fell away from the faith. They lacked courage to break with tradition and to withstand temptation. But those believers who remained steadfast became the church's foundation blocks and precious stones. Jesus made it clear that courage is not something you manufacture out of feelings or fantasies. We find courage in the sources of courage God has provided. Courage comes from faith in the goodness of God, faith in the way of Christ, and faith in the future God is preparing. Theologian Paul Tillich wrote a book with the interesting title, *The Courage to Be*. Isn't it true that it takes courage just to live, much less to excel? Every day is a contest between success and failure that keeps us engaged. Without the resources of faith and courage our days are filled with fear, rather than meaning and adventure. What do we need? Our greatest need is not for more money or better health. These are things that can be taken away from us. Our greatest need is for courage to take what comes as best we can. Finding courage in danger is half the battle. We need the skills and the resources to deal with the challenges that confront us in life. But without courage, whatever skills we possess are useless and whatever resources we have are wasted. Courage is the energy that keeps us going and growing.

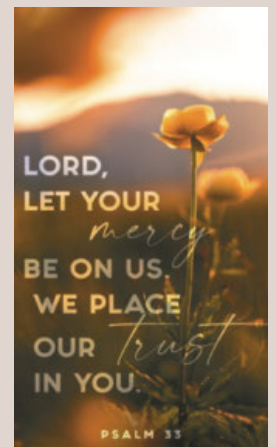

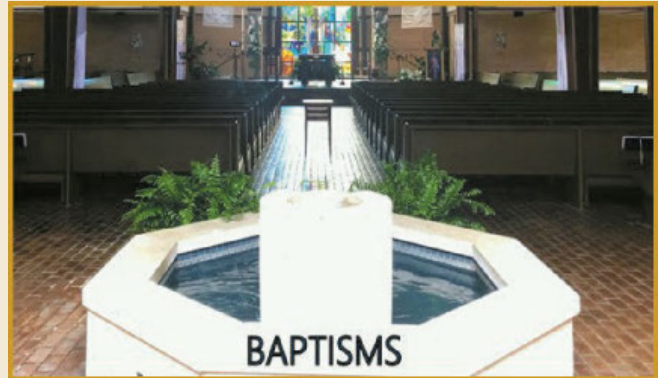

First Eucharist Weekend Reminders

First Eucharist will be celebrated on **May 6 & 7** during the 4:30 Vigil mass on Saturday and during the 9:00 am, 11:00 am and 5:30 pm masses on Sunday.

Please pray for our Candidates who will be receiving their First Eucharist this year.

FIRST EUCHARIST SEATING:

First Eucharist Candidates will be **seated** with each other in **alphabetical order**, in **reserved pews** in the **main aisle** of the **Church**. Their First Eucharist certificate, nametag, and banner will be placed in their pew. Families and guests may choose to sit in either transept or the main nave of the church. Families may invite as many guests as they would like. Ushers will be available to assist in directing the children and their families to their pews.

RECEPTION OF THE EUCHARIST: During Communion time, the priest will instruct the children to come forward and receive their First Communion before the rest of the assembly. The First Communicants have been prepared by their teachers/catechists to receive the Body of Christ in their hand. Reception of the Cup will be offered at this time. If you wish your child to receive the Blood of Christ, please allow them to taste the wine at home. For more information, please click here for [First Eucharist Guidelines](#).

John Ballance will be taking [First Communion Pictures](#) of your child. He will photograph each child receiving their First Communion at all Masses and will also have a photo studio setup with a backdrop in the Parish Hall to shoot individuals of your child as well as family pictures.

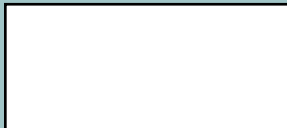
