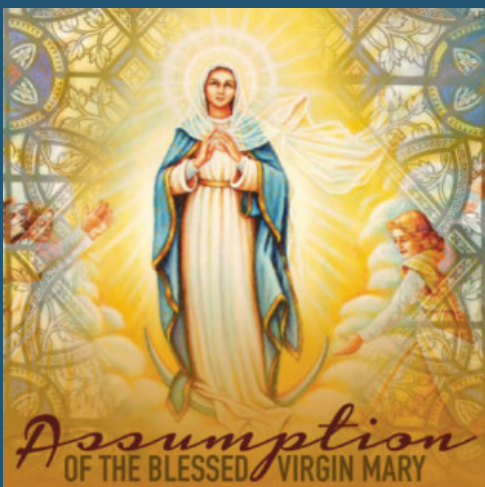

The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Tuesday, August 15th is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Mass times are 6:00 AM, 8:00 AM (All School Mass), 12:00 Noon (livestreamed), and 6:00 PM.

The Feast of the Assumption commemorates the death of Mary and her bodily assumption into Heaven before her body could begin to decay—a foretaste of our own bodily resurrection at the end of time. Because it signifies the Blessed Virgin's passing into eternal life, it is the most important of all Marian feasts.

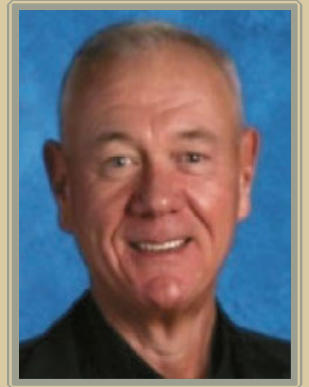

Our Challenge

Dear friends,

Our first reading this weekend from the first Book of Kings reflects that the prophet Elijah was on the run. He had routed the priests of Baal and Queen Jezebel who was threatening his life. When at risk or in danger, we often expect God to do something dramatic or spectacular. Elijah hid in a cave where he learned an important lesson. God comes to us less often in displays of majesty and might than in "a tiny whispering sound." One of the great concerns of St. Paul's life was why most of his fellow Jews had rejected Jesus as the Messiah. This caused him such great pain that he expressed his willingness to be "cut off" from Christ himself for the sake of his people. Paul had no answers concerning this mystery, but he never wavered in his faith in God. Our gospel story this weekend is the well known one about Jesus "walking on the water and quieting the storm" for his disciples. It was much more than a remarkable, miraculous event. As followers of Christ we will often find ourselves in stormy waters, both in the world and within ourselves. It is then that we must trust in Christ, for he will be with us and will still our storms. Hear these relevant words: "We live in the midst of alarms; anxiety beclouds the future; we expect some new disaster with each newspaper we read." Relevant, but not contemporary. They were written by Abraham Lincoln. There are always problems. Some of them can be solved. The question is what we will do about the others, and whether we will trust God when we face the problems we can't solve. The vicissitudes of this world show no favoritism. Bad things happen to good people. The innocent suffer, as well as the guilty. None of our human situations are permanent. In this world, circumstances constantly change. Meanwhile, our faith is in what is unchanging - - - the reality of God's kingdom, which alone is eternal. When facing difficulties that are beyond our power to change, we trust in the ultimate triumph of God's will. "The lowest ebb," wrote Longfellow, "is the turn of the tide." The tides and our times are in God's hands.

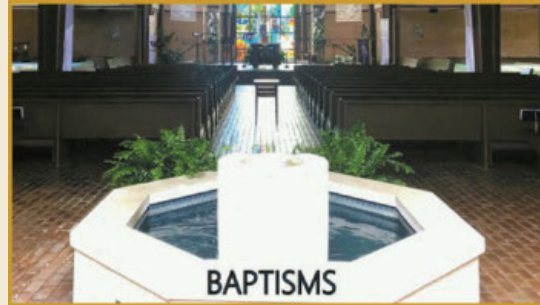

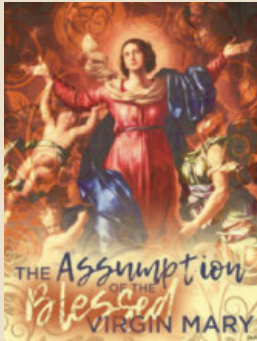


